PGC ADVENTURE SCAVENGER HUNT

- Take a picture of your surroundings and caption it with your observations (What are you seeing? How does it make you feel? And of course, the name of the location: city and state). Here are things to keep an eye out for. Take this list and tell us what you saw:





- **A pollinator and what it's pollinating**
 - We saw several *Gnophaela aequinoctialis* (Mexican moth) pollinating different flowers
- **2 plant species**
 - Mexican White Oak (*Quercus polymorpha*)

- smooth-bark Mexican pine (*Pinus pseudostrobus*)
- **1 bird species**
 - The Mexican Jay = gray-breasted jay (*Aphelocoma wollweberi*)
- **Wildlife**
 - During the hike we were lucky to see a Coati, which is a member of the raccoon family. Coatis are very common mammals in the Ecological park of Chipinque. As well as squirrels climbing on trees.
- **The terrain (is it Dusty? Dry, Grassy? Muddy, Well-trodden?)**
 - The terrain overall was grassy and a little muddy because of the past rainfall in our city.
- **The sky (is it Cloudy? Clear? Sunny?)**
 - We were lucky we did our hiking on a beautiful day full with sunny and partially cloudy with puffy white clouds.
- **What is something that took your breath away?**
 - Once you arrive to the upper most part of the mountain, the view you witness is out of this world, up from there we could see all of our city covered with puffy white clouds.
- **What is something that surprised you?**
