Below is an amazon review I found when I was looking at the price of 409. I completely agree with this user and believe that while the companies know their products are harmful, they still do nothing to help consumers.

I bought the anti-bacterial by mistake, as I have concerns about the harm that results from wiping out too much flora. I only mention this because of the overly noxious fumes from this product that seems to be worse than the same product without the lemon and/or without the anti-bacterial chemicals.
