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

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
Our D.I.Y. Party

It is also a causing factor of many dermatological diseases!


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
This chemical has been associated with harm to aquatic life in high amounts.

He told her that he used the "Think Dirty" App to see whether or not the daily facial moisturizer he uses every morning can cause harm. She was very surprised to learn that such an everyday body product has a moderate level of toxicity (Score: 6) according to the app and that it has chemical ingredients that have been associated with cancer. It really is scary to see that so many of the body products we use have chemicals that can hurt our well-beings.





We then decided to find a DIY recipe for a foaming face wash on the dontmesswithmama.com site, successfully finding a DIY recipe by Homemade Mommy titled "Foaming Face Wash." This seemed like a viable alternative to Amanda's face wash, and we decided to make it for our party!

The ingredients needed in this foam face wash were:

- 1/2 teaspoon of Extra Virgin Olive Oil
- 1/3 cup castile soap
- 10 drops of orange essential oil
- 6 drops of rosemary essential oil
- 4 drops Lemongrass essential oil
- 2/3 cup water
