I AGREE TO THE OFFICIAL PROJECT GREEN CHALLENGE FINALS RULES

Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

By entering this Challenge, Participants accept and agree to be bound by these Official Rules, as well as any rules or requirements, including the Terms of Service, posted on the PGC Website (www.projectgreenchallenge.com), or in connection with any Challenge Task. Any violation of any of these rules or terms may result in disqualification. All decisions of the judges regarding this Challenge are final and binding in all respects.

1. CHALLENGE FINALS

If you are selected as a PGC 2020 finalist, your Challenge period begins on November 1, 2020 and ends on April 25, 2021.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR CHALLENGE FINALS

Only students who are enrolled in high school, college, or graduate school are eligible to be selected as a Challenge Finalist. Students must be at least 16 years old by March 31, 2021. To be eligible as a Challenge Finalist and awarded a Prize Package, participant must be available to attend the Vitural Finals November 21-22, 2020 and available to travel to San Francisco on the morning of April 22, 2021 and return home early morning April 25, 2021. If travel is not recommended due to Covid, the PGC Finals will be held virtually. **If you are unable to travel, please do not submit an application.** If you are a minor and selected as a finalist, you must have signed permission from your parent or legal guardian in order to travel to San Francisco and participate in the PGC Challenge Finals. You must also be able to travel on your own.

3. HOW TO APPLY

Beginning on October 26, 2020 at 6am PT through October 31, 2020 @ 6:00 am PT, participants can apply for the Project Green Challenge Finals. If you have been participating as a team, only one team member may represent the team. That person should be the one filling out the application. The prize package will be awarded to that person as the representative of the team. Participants will be asked to complete the following as part of their final exam;

- Climate Action Project Proposal (due by October 29 by 6am PT)
- PGC Exit Survey (due by October 30 by 6am PT)

• Head Shot Photo, Head to Toe Photo, Biography, Portfolio, and Cover letter (due by October 30 by 6am PT)

• Final Exam (due by October 31 by 6am PT)

• Credit A reflective Video 3-5 minutes in length highlighting your PGC experience. (due by October 31 by 6am PT)

4. JUDGING CRITERIA

The judging criteria to determine PGC 2020 finalists is based on the following:

• total number of points accrued over the 30 days

- depth and quality of work submitted
- number of daily challenge wins
- final exam
- final video recap
- climate action project plans

5. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

Only one student from each school will be selected as a Challenge Finalist. – PGC 2020 Challenge Finalists will be notified by 9 pm PT on November 2, 2020.

• Finalists (either an individual participant or a team leader) will be notified by email and will be required to confirm their attendance at the PGC Finals by email or phone within 24 hours. If the potential finalist does not respond within 24 hours, they will forfeit their spot at the Challenge Finals.

• Upon contacting a finalist and determining that they have met all eligibility requirements for the PGC Finals, including a liability release, parental permission if a minor, and availability to attend a Virtual PGC Finals or travel to San Francisco from 4/22-4/25, such individual will be declared a "Challenge Finalist".

6. PRIZE DESCRIPTION

PGC 2020 Grand Prize and Finalist Prizes. A list of the Grand Prize and Finalist Prize packages are featured on the PGC website. Should any of the prizes become unavailable, the Sponsor may select another prize of equal or greater value. A full list of prizes will be available on November 20.

7. TAXES

All federal, state and/or local income and other taxes, if any, are the winner's sole responsibility. A potential winner will be required to provide tax reporting information prior to the award of the prize.

8. CHALLENGE SUBMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS AND PERMISSIONS

Should there be a conflict between the laws of the State of California and any other laws, the conflict will be resolved in favor of the laws of the State of California. All judgments or awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket damages (excluding attorneys' fees) associated with participation in this Challenge and shall not include any indirect, punitive, incidental and/or consequential damages.

13. PRIVACY

Information provided by participants during the registration process will be treated in accordance with Sponsor's Privacy Policy (turninggreen.org) except that a potential winner's contact information may be provided to a partner or prize provider solely for purposes of prize fulfillment.
