

It is a solution to the amount of loose cables in the city with that it seeks to encourage order and good practices


This idea tries to imitate the clamping mechanism to keep the light cables and avoid accidents

To help urban order and avoid accidents due to loose cables




I exchange clothes with my little sister and my parents sometimes also give me some clothes to wear inside the house.


## • Which level of the Buyerarchy of Needs seems the easiest for you? Which is the most difficult?

You can also accept the clothing of others that fits you or is your style and even if you don't use it to go out you can use it inside the house






Clothing can be cut into long pieces and then attached to a short stick to create a fabric duster.
