Timothy Grayson

- Running for CA State Assembly as a Democrat.
- Experience: Critical Response Chaplain, experience with Assembly, was mayor for a year.

- Biggest donors: California Optometric Association, Josefowitz, Nickolas Frederick Myro, and Bay Area Legislative Leaders PAC.
- They believe that higher education should be more affordable.
 - Authored AB 1674 to ensure that qualified CA students would not be denied admission to UC schools instead of less qualified out-of-state students.
- Advocates for victims of domestic violence, human trafficking, and abuse.
 - Secured \$10 million in state funding for Family Justice Centers across California. This funding reached new communities, expanding and streamlining services for victims of interpersonal violence.
- Their opponent, Jane Proctor, is a Republican with unknown qualifications (except ballerina) and no elaboration on topics that are important to them (such as religious freedom and environmental conservation).

Joe Biden

- Running for President of the United States as a Democrat.
- Experience: US Senator from 1973-2009, chairing the Senate Judiciary Committee and the Committee on Foreign Relations. Vice president from 2009-2017.
- Biggest donors: Video game companies, agriculture, hedge funds.
- They believe that capital punishment should be abolished.
 - Website says “capital punishment is unfairly applied,” pointing out that new technologies have acquitted people on death row.
- Against private prisons.
 - As a government watchdog found in 2016, “private prisons are less safe than their federally maintained counterparts.”
- In favor of universal background checks for firearms.
 - As Biden’s website points out, there is a loophole in the system currently in which guns can be sold at gun shows from unlicensed dealers without background checks.
