## GREENER CHALLENGE

**Research if your country has a similar, major climate action plan in the works. What are its most important components? Is there anything you would like to see added or removed? What issues do you think should be addressed first?**

In Peru, on April 17, 2018, it promulgated the Framework Law on Climate Change that aims to establish the principles, approaches and general provisions to coordinate, articulate, design, execute, report, monitor, evaluate and disseminate public policies for the Comprehensive, participatory and transparent management of climate change adaptation and mitigation measures, in order to reduce the country's vulnerability to climate change, take advantage of the opportunities for low-carbon growth and comply with the international commitments assumed by the State before the Convention United Nations Framework on Climate Change, with an intergenerational approach. This was a great step at the national level to be able to decisively face the climate emergency.

However, it does have some shortcomings, one of which is being able to allocate the necessary financial resources to the committee of experts on climate change and energy transition. In addition, actions should also be included against emissions from heavy goods transport by road, given that 7.5% of total national greenhouse gas emissions came exclusively from them.

**Write a letter to your elected officials urging them to enact a climate action plan. Tell them why we need a Green New Deal (or equivalent) now and highlight its importance to you and which areas of focus resonate most and why.**

Political officials of Peru, I address all of you on behalf of young people and citizens demanding that the issue of climate change be prioritized in the Peruvian agenda, since each sector is responsible for the implementation of its adaptation and mitigation measures, being items that not only correspond to the Ministry of the Environment, in addition to being a cross-cutting issue that affects each sector (agriculture, energy and mines, production, etc.). We should be talking about a greater increase in the participation of renewable energies in the energy matrix, water security in a context of climate change, food security, sustainable cities and resilient to climate change, among others. Public and private investment must be directed against a long-term climate change context.

We demand that mitigation measures and, above all, adaptation to climate change be carried out urgently, as well as that ambition be increased. This is considering that, despite being a developing country and with a low contribution of greenhouse gases, we rank third among the countries most vulnerable to the consequences of climate change (Tyndall Center Institute, 2004). Even the latest Germanwatch report, the Global Climate Risk Index 2019, places Peru in fifth place worldwide of the countries most affected in 2017.

If we do not prioritize climate change from now on, it will have a direct impact on the well-being of future generations, preventing their optimal development and making it even more difficult to deal with problems such as inequality, poverty, social exclusion and others that affect us and will continue to affect us.
