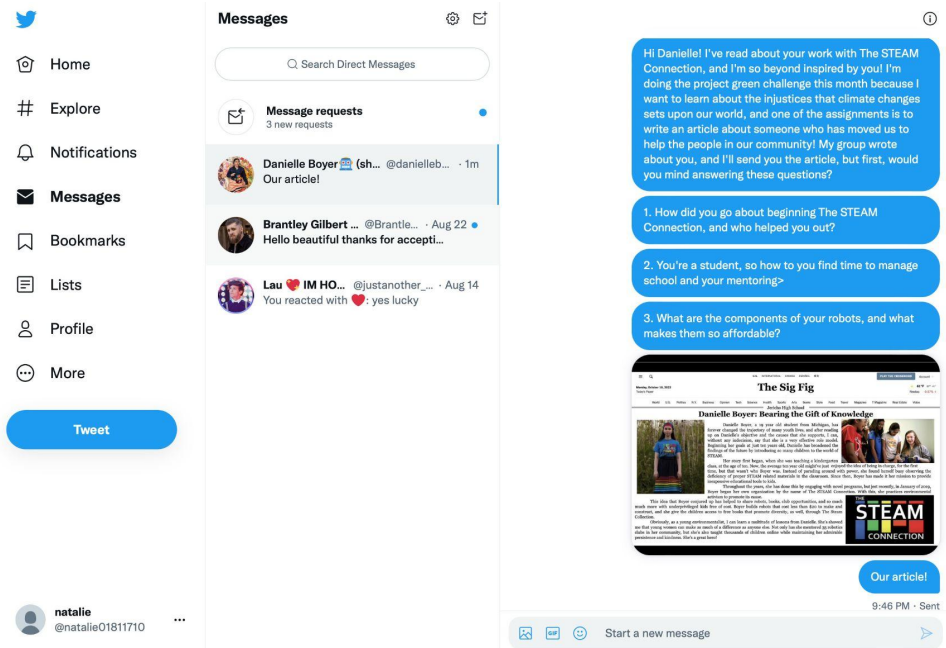

Her story first began, when she was teaching a kindergarten class, at the age of ten. Instead of parading around with power, she found herself busy observing the deficiency of proper STEAM related materials in the classroom. Since then, Boyer has made it her mission to provide inexpensive educational tools to kids.

Throughout the years, she has done this by engaging with novel programs, but just recently, in January of 2019, Boyer began her own organization by the name of The STEAM Connection. With this, she practices environmental activism to promote its cause.

This idea that Boyer conjured up has helped to share robots, books, club opportunities, and so much much more with underprivileged kids free of cost. Boyer builds robots that cost less than \$20 to make and construct, and she give the children access to free books that promote diversity, as well, through The Steam Collection.
