

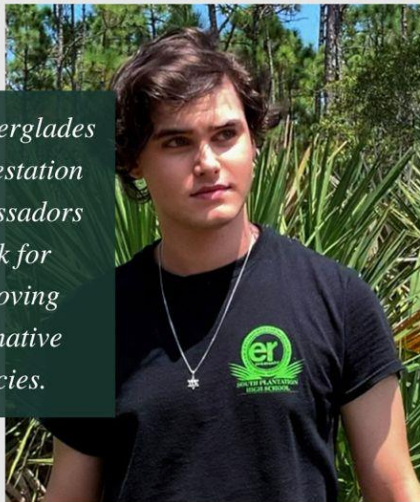

ABOUT THE NONNATIVE SPECIES.

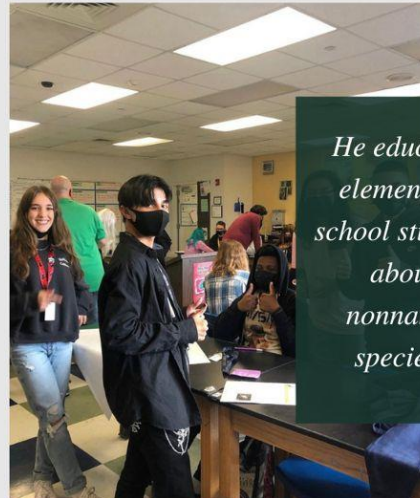
NOWADAYS, HE IS AN
