There was a very positive change there. As can be seen in the picture bike park for kids was made. Green grass and trees made this place a nice hangout place for kids, teenagers and adults.

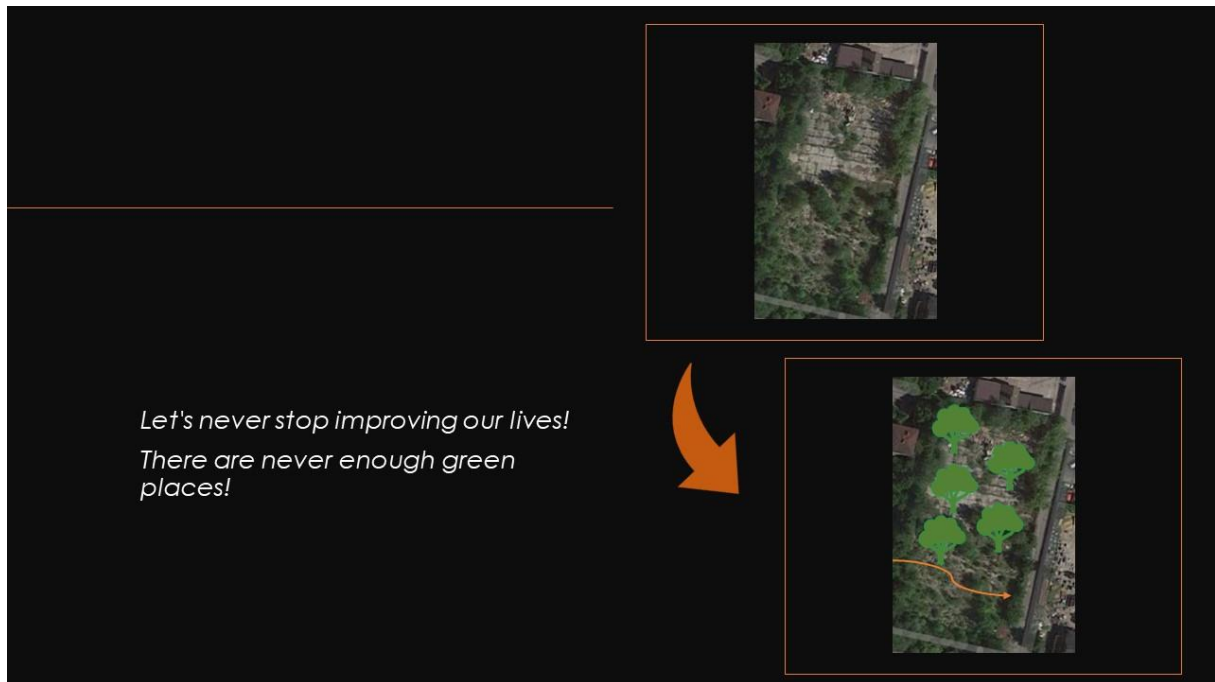
It's not hard to find in my city places that could use similar treatment....
