#### PROTESTS AGAINST ECOLTEC

In 2009 the town of **Apaxco** in Mexico has been **protesting** against against a Swiss cement plant in the region "**Ecoltec**" which has had **detrimental** effects on the local communities health, on the **environment**, and on the overall **quality of life** in the area.



- Located in the State of Mexico north east of Toluca
- Over the years there have been multiple protests from locals demanding governmental protection as well as organized groups that call for the government to stop cement plants across the country.
- For example "Frente de Comunidades en Contra de la Incineración" which had their first meeting in 2013.



### **Health risks**

Exposure to pollutants from the plant has **impacted the local communities health** causing respiratory problems, irritation in the eyes, cardiovascular problems, and even cancer.

Apart from that, 60% of children in the community have memory problems.

Moreover on Mar. 21, 2009, **11 local men died** while cleaning out a wastewater pumping station of the local water company.

# **Environmental Degradation**

The cement plant has **contaminated** the water sources in the community with chemicals such as nitrogen oxides

This decreased the availability of drinking water and put the ecosystems at risk.



## How to help

Now is the time to **educate** and **mobilize** by sharing information and speaking about the impacts of factories and industrial plants on local Mexican communities and to pressurize governments to act.

It is important to **vote** for governments that will **support** these **underrepresented communities** and advocate for the implementation of **sustainable practices and technologies** within the plant to reduce emissions, improve air and water quality, and minimize its ecological footprint.

We must prioritize discussions and policymaking that actively **engage marginalized communities**, as they consistently bear the most severe repercussions of climate change
