- fair trade international- aims to connect disadvantaged producers and consumers, promote fairer trading conditions, and empower producers to have more control over their position and poverty.

- fair trade USA- has standards and compliance criteria that must be met in order to receive a license. enables sustainable development and community empowerment through a more equitable global trade model that benefits many
- fair for life- positive relations between producers and cooperatives. Non product specified standard. every step of production can be certified, or just the finished product
- world fair trade organization- 10 principles of fair trade. enable producers to improve livelihoods and communities
- fair trade federation- combined 2 principles from the world fair trade organization and goes by 9 fair trade principles. aim to create a just and systainable global economic system in which purchase and production choices are made with consideration of peoples and environments wellbeing
