- 1. Energy. We must transition to renewable energies and legislate for people to have access to these alternatives. The world can't keep burning fossil fuels that pollute the environment and endanger public health.
- 2. Water. The Water Department in Mexico requires a deep organizational change in operation and legislation. A strong campaign with enough resources is critical to deliver maintenance to infrastructure and plan for climate related shortages.
- Biodiversity and Natural Protected Areas. The ecosystem services we get through the Natural Capital are invaluable and should be protected against land use change and illegal practices like mining, logging, and hunting.
- 4. Transportation. Even though I'm biased towards cities, the world needs to star phasing out on car dependency both in infrastructure and quantity. More efficient and sustainable modes of transportation already exist, and societies need to embrace them.
- 5. Bring the food industry to comply with health requirements. Again, a strong campaign with sustained education to the population about the dangers of ultra processed foods. Food industry is not a bad idea, but they need to be responsible to the consumers and deliver healthy products, we must also phase out on excessive junk and fast food.

I would have to pick Dr. José Sarukhan, he's a Mexican biologist who proposed the creation of the National Commission for Biodiversity (CONABIO) in 1992 to safeguard, learn from, and do a sustainable use of the Mexican Natural Capital. He's the honorary Coordinator of this Commission, and a science advisor to the federal government. He's been successful in advocating for the Natural Capital in the political sphere since CONABIO serves as an advisory board to other Federal Departments like Agriculture, Natural Protected Areas, and Environment and Natural Resources.
