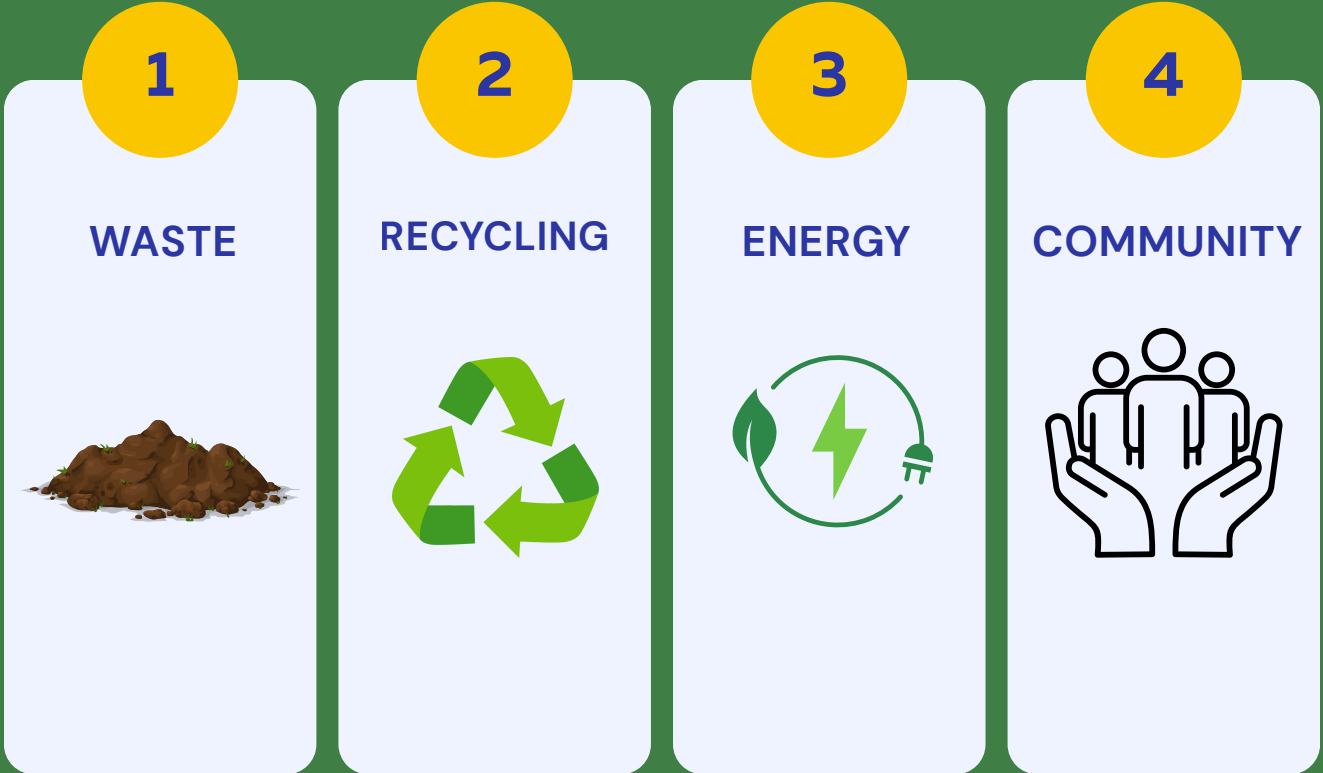

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE “RECYCLINGHOF”

At the Recyclinghof Großostheim, residents bring in waste like garden cuttings, wood, and recyclables, which are then processed into compost and wood chips for renewable energy, while also serving as a hub for proper waste disposal and environmental education.

HOW IT WORKS



WHY IT MATTERS?

- cuts emissions
- educates and connects people

Composting garden waste and using wood chips avoids landfill methane and replaces fossil fuels.

Wood chips heat schools in Pflaumheim and Ringheim

- keeps the town clean
- Supports schools and buildings

Proper disposal limits illegal dumping and improves public spaces.

Tours, upcycling projects, and clean-ups engage students and the community.
