On behalf of the people of the Bangshal Union, I am writing to express my deep concern about the increasing flooding and infrastructure damage in our area, particularly around the old pond near my home. On October 1st, heavy rainfall caused the pond's decades-old side wall to collapse, flooding nearby roads with waist-deep water. Tragically, a middle-aged man lost his life after falling into the pond during the storm, and just two weeks earlier, a young boy was electrocuted when a live wire fell into the floodwater. These heartbreaking incidents highlight how vulnerable our community has become to the growing impacts of climate change and inadequate maintenance. Local climate action is no longer optional—it is a necessity for saving lives and protecting our environment. I urge the Union Parishad to take immediate steps to rebuild and reinforce the pond wall using sustainable design, improve drainage systems, and implement regular maintenance programs.

I also request that youth from our community be included in future planning and awareness initiatives. Young people are eager to contribute innovative ideas for climate resilience, early warning systems, and safe infrastructure.
