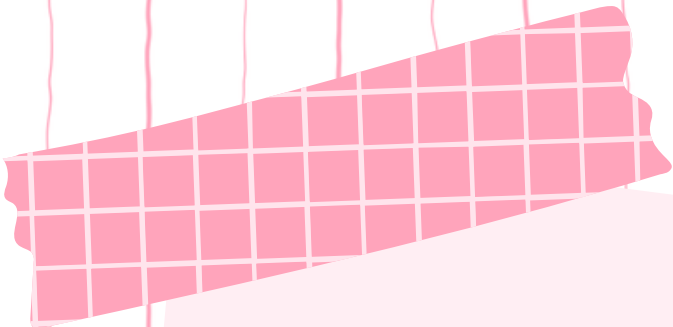




Fast Fashion in My Closet
