I explored WWF's forest hub page and learned about the crucial role forests play in sustaining biodiversity, supporting local communities, and mitigating climate change. Forests are home to most of the world's terrestrial species and provide essential resources like food, wood, and clean air for billions of people.

Did you know more than 3 billion people live within 1 km of a forest? That's nearly 75% of all non-urban populations globally!

Forests also act as carbon sinks, storing over 660 gigatons of carbon, which is about 18 times the amount humans emit annually.

Yet, threats like illegal logging, agriculture expansion, and infrastructure development are destroying forests at alarming rates. For example, **the Amazon lost ~17% of its forest cover in the last 50 years.**

To contribute, I chose to sign **WWF's forest protection petitions/pledges**. These actions are simple but powerful ways to push for sustainable practices and policies that preserve forests for future generations.

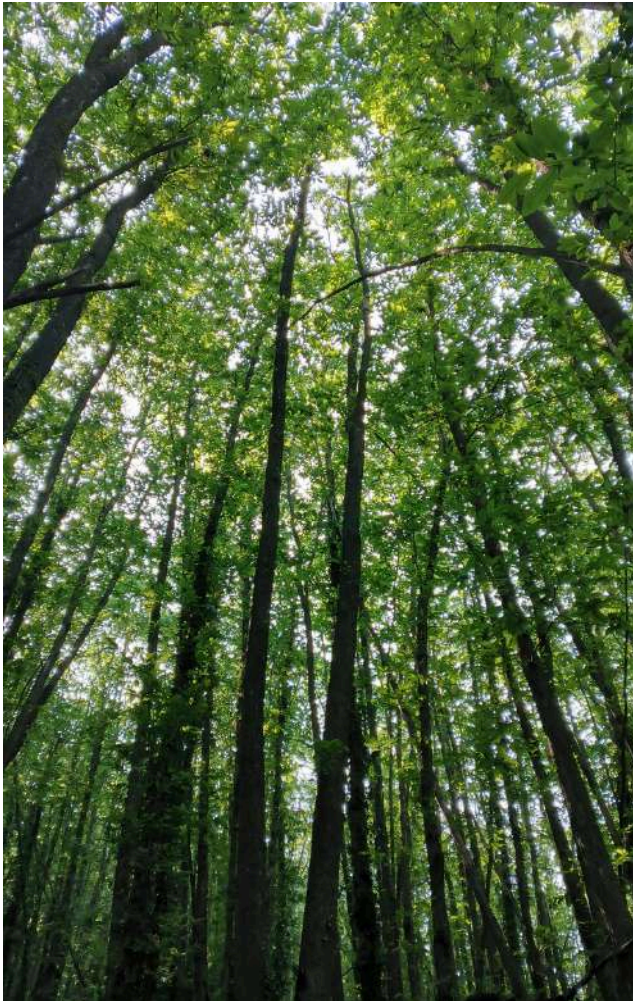
WHY I CHOSE THIS ACTION:

- Signing petitions, sending messages to my elected officials, calling my representatives, and being a voice for the planet to help create and support policies that recognize and respect the importance of nature.
