






This is a product that has hazard rating level 4 (0-10). It has the moderate risk for causing cancer, allergies and developmental&reproductive toxic. Most ingredients have good scores based on EWG criteria, but there are some concerning ingredients. For example, Propylene Glycol might cause irritation in human bodies, bioaccumulation and contamination. In addition, one of the ingredient, 42090, is made from petroleum, which means it wastes natural resrouces.

Product #2

OJOOK Bamboo Salt Toothpaste With nHA, Peppermint + Pine

This is the product that completely passes the strictest regulation of EWG standards. It provides full transparency of ingredients and avoid any hazard ingredients. Some ingredients include glycerin, hydrated cilica, hydroxyapatite and sea salt, which are environmentally friendly and does not pose any significant health risks. The only setback for this product is that the cost is higher than toothpaste of Crest.
