3 Minutes — Each Person Shares One Local Climate Issue

Our group of five (Asongu, Esther, Joseph, Mirabel, and Brian) met for a 20-minute “Campus Roots” huddle under the University of Buea Environmental Club Garden.

Each person shared an issue they care deeply about:

Name	Local Climate Issue Shared
Asongu	Plastic litter around the campus and lack of recycling bins.
Esther	Increasing food waste from canteens and hostel kitchens.
Joseph	Minimal tree cover on campus causing heat and erosion.
Mirabel	Flooding and poor drainage after rainfall.
Brian	Low student participation in sustainability initiatives.

10 Minutes — Pick One Issue + Brainstorm Three Possible Actions

After discussion, the team voted on the most immediate issue:

Plastic pollution and lack of greenery on campus.

We brainstormed three possible 30-day actions:

A) Plastic-Free Campus Drive:

- Organize waste segregation bins in five key student areas.
- Host mini awareness talks during lunch breaks.

B) “Adopt-a-Spot” Tree & Garden Program:

- Students adopt one neglected corner and plant native trees or flowers.
- Add simple signage: *“This corner cares for the planet.”*

C) Campus Upcycling Challenge:

- Encourage creative reuse of plastic bottles into planters and decor.
- Exhibit winning designs on campus.



7 Minutes — Choose One Action + Assign Roles + Set Date

Chosen Action:

🌱 *“Adopt-a-Spot” Tree & Garden Program* — A 30-day mission to reclaim small neglected spaces around the University of Buea and turn them into mini eco-gardens.

Goal:

Transform five unused corners of the university into living, student-managed green areas by **November 25, 2025**.

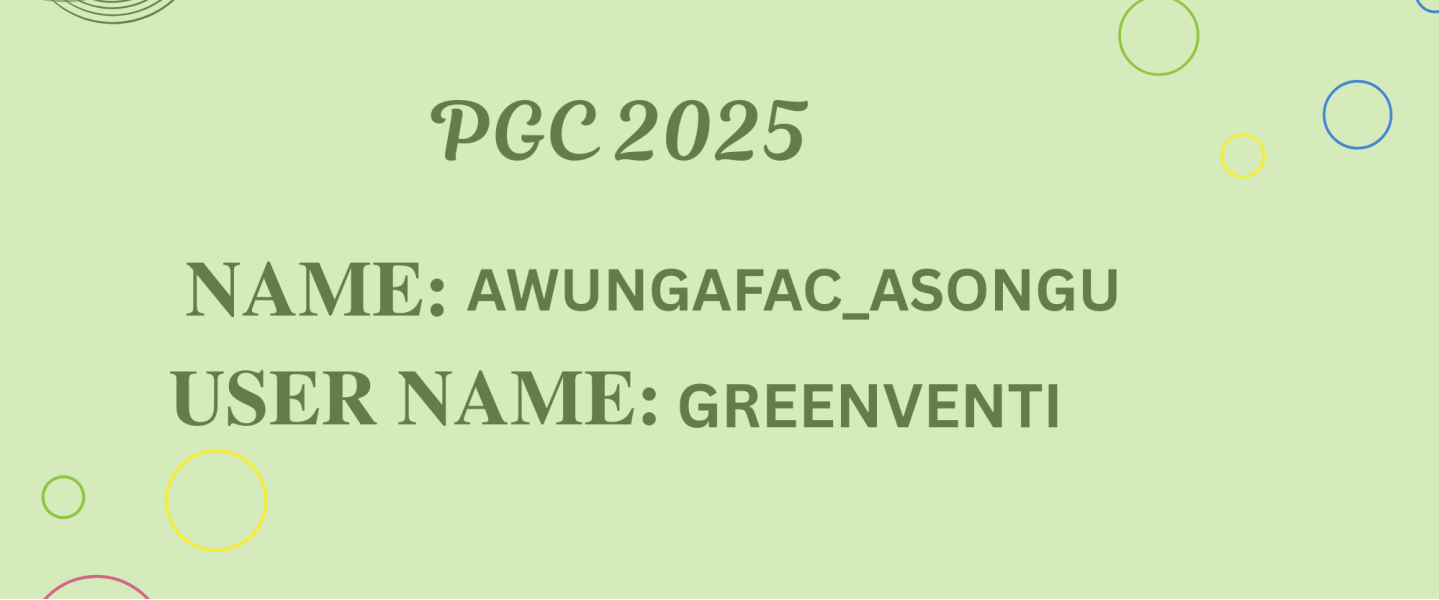
