Brainstorming Three Actions:

1) Stop eating processed food

- 2) Offer more support in local ocean clean ups such as doing volunteering and spreading information (This option was the best choice for us since we have a lot of people we know that hold organizations and clubs dedicated in environmental action
- 3) Stop using single used plastics and switch to metal bottles
 - 7 minutes: choose one action and assign roles + set a date.

We decided to choose the most impactful action out of the three: Offer more support in local ocean clean ups such as hands-on volunteering and spreading information.

2 people reaching out to **Environmental Club** at our school to see if they're holding ocean clean up (<u>Jolyna and Hannah</u>)


2 people reaching out to **Aylus (organization)** to see if they're holding ocean clean up (<u>Jivika and Joanna</u>)
