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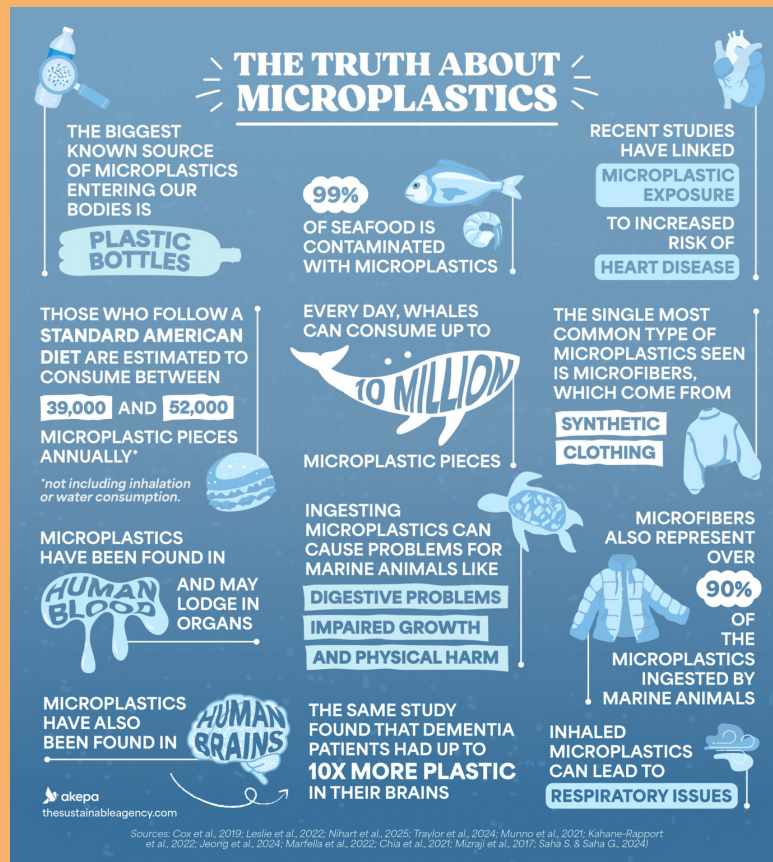

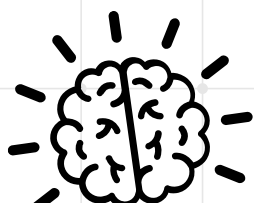

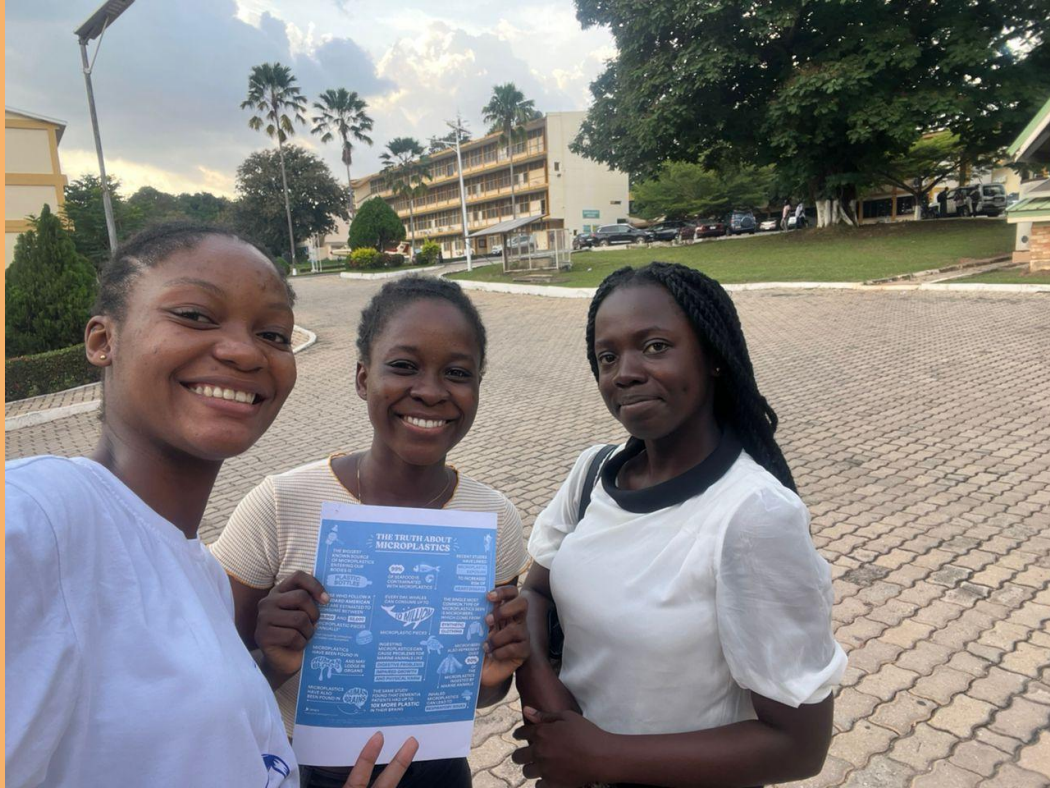
Success checks

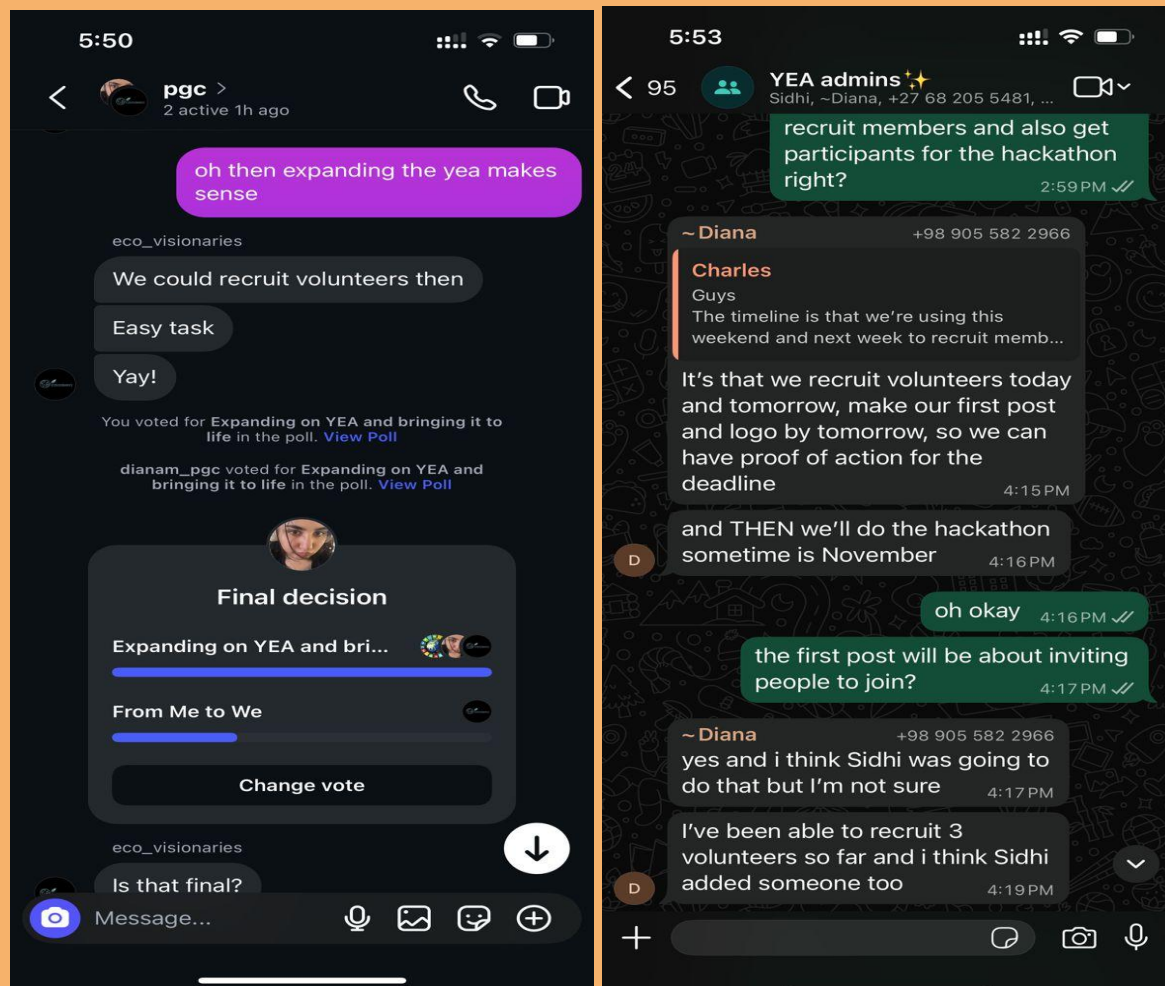
ACTION PLAN 2

Why It Matters

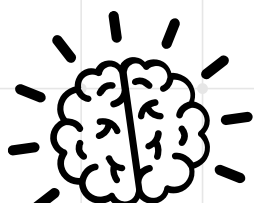
It matters because many young people still lack access to accurate information and global connections. By forming the YEA, we're creating a space where youth can learn, collaborate, and take real action for the planet.

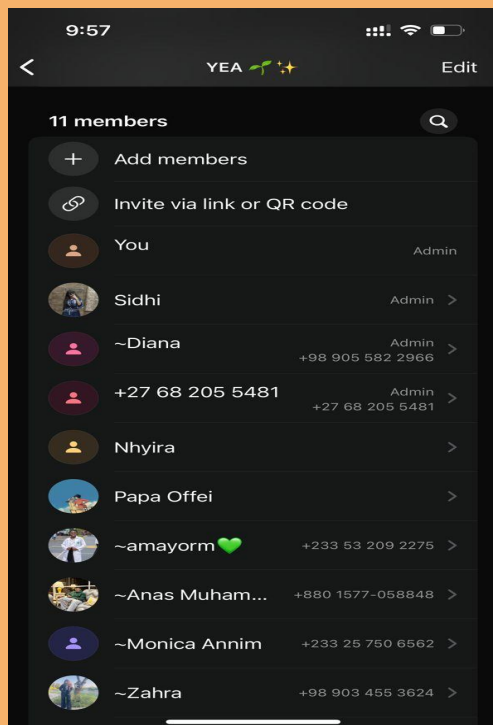
