

INTRODUCTION

The Youth Environmental Alliance (YEA) was created to empower youth globally to take climate-positive action, foster collaboration, and amplify voices for a sustainable future.

Purpose becomes real when youth act together, and YEA provides a structured platform to make that happen.

Why It Matters:

- Global Youth Engagement: Youth aged 13+ can submit solutions addressing climate, energy, water, waste, and biodiversity challenges.
- Innovation & Action: Encourages participants to move beyond ideas, creating tangible solutions.
- Community Building: By connecting youth across countries, YEA fosters cross-cultural collaboration, mentorship opportunities, and long-term engagement in sustainability.

YEA's first major initiative is the **Global Youth Climate Hackathon**, designed to bring these goals to life.

YEA FORMATION - DETAILED ACTIONS

Team Formation:

- Core members: Daina, Charles, Sidhi &
- Ayanda.
- Defined mission, vision, and objectives:
 - Mission: Empower youth to take climate action globally.
 - Vision: A world where youth-led solutions drive sustainability.
 - Objectives: Create events, campaigns, and platforms for youth participation.

Branding & Identity:

- Created a logo that symbolizes global youth collaboration
- Developed the tagline: "One Planet. One Purpose. Countless Ideas"
- Established social media presence: Instagram, Whatsapp, and email channels for outreach and updates
- Defined **team roles for clarity**: leadership, outreach, logistics, social media, volunteer coordination.

Operational Planning:

- Developed a roadmap for activities and events
- Created templates for communication with volunteers, sponsors, and judges
- Prepared a timeline to organize recruitment, hackathon launch, and ongoing engagement



VOLUNTEER RECRUITMENT & TEAM BUILDING

Recruitment Process:

- Reached out to peers, clubs, and online communities to recruit 7 motivated volunteers (total 11)
- Assigned roles based on strengths:
 - Social Media Promotion
 - Hackathon Logistics & Coordination
 - Community Outreach
 - Volunteer Engagement & Team Support


Impact of Volunteer Team:

- Enabled YEA to handle multiple operational tasks simultaneously
- Amplified outreach for hackathon participation
- Built a sense of community ownership and leadership among volunteers

Reflection:

 Recruiting and organizing volunteers highlighted the importance of teamwork, delegation, and clear communication. Even a small, motivated team can achieve global impact when roles are clearly defined.

GLOBAL YOUTH CLIMATE HACKATHON

- Participants: Ages 13+, open globally
- Live Dates: Oct 26 Nov 2, 2025
- Platform: Devpost portal for submissions and tracking

Steps Taken to Launch:

Promotion:

- Portal Setup: Configured registration, submission guidelines, and judging criteria
- 02 Social media posts across Instagram, Whatsapp and Discord.
 - Partner outreach to schools and youth organizations
- Prizes & Mentorship: Mentorship sessions with climate experts

- Eco-friendly swag: reusable notebooks, seed kits, sustainable merch
- Certificates of achievement

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Judging & Recognition:

- Judges and sponsors to be contacted, to provide guidance and review submissions
- Recognition includes social media features and digital certificates

Expected Outcomes:

- Minimum 20 projects submitted globally
- At least 5 cross-border collaboration teams
- Increased awareness and participation in youth-led climate action

Reflection:

Launching the hackathon demonstrated how digital platforms can connect youth globally, fostering innovation and providing real-world opportunities for environmental impact.

Nov 8-10	Hackathon judging and winner announcements
Nov 10 onward	Expand YEA activities: social media campaigns, local drives, ongoing youth engagement

MEASURABLE SUCCESS CHECKS

YEA & Hackathon Metrics:

- Volunteers recruited: 7
- Hackathon sign-ups: Target 50+ youth globally
- Sponsors/judges engaged: Target 3+
- Partner organisations: Target 4+ (Achieved 1)

Impact Metrics:

- Hackathon project submissions: 20+
- Cross-border collaboration: ≥5 teams
- Social media reach: posts, shares, and participant engagement




